



## Texas Motor Vehicle Traffic Crash Facts 2023

## **Texas Motor Vehicle Statistics: At a Glance**

- Texas experienced a decrease in the number of motor vehicle traffic fatalities. 4,254 people died in auto accidents in 2023, down 3.5% from the 4.407 deaths recorded in 2022.
- 254,095 people suffered injuries in motor vehicle accidents in 2023, up 2.1% from 248,731 in 2022.
- There were 558,007 reportable crashes in 2023, up 0.4% from 555,583 in 2022.

## Based on reportable crashes in 2023:

- 1 person was killed every 2 hours, 4 minutes.
- 1 person was injured every 2 minutes, 4 seconds.
- 1 reportable crash occurred every
   57 seconds.

## Texas Fatalities: 2023 versus 2022

- ↑ In 2023, there were 1,108 people killed in crashes occurring in intersections or related to an intersection.
- The majority of fatalities in 2023 occurred on a Sunday, totaling 695.
- ↑ In 2023, the majority of fatal accidents occurred between 9:00 pm and 9:59 pm (273).
- The majority of fatal accidents in 2023 occurred in October (349).
- ↓ 1,419 individuals were killed in speed-related crashes in 2023.
- 398 individuals were killed in distracted drivingrelated crashes in 2023.
- 1,138 individuals were killed in alcohol-related crashes in 2023.
- ↑ There were 595 motorcyclists (operators and passengers) killed in 2023. 45% (265) were not wearing helmets at the time of the crash.
- ↓ Pedestrian fatalities totaled 802 in 2023.
- ↑ Pedalcyclist fatalities totaled 103 in 2023.
- ↑ There were five crashes that resulted in six or more fatalities in 2023.
- ↓ 501 individuals died in crashes involving an unlicensed driver in 2023.

- ↓ In 2022, there were 1,020 people killed in crashes occurring in intersections or related to an intersection.
- ↑ The majority of fatalities in 2022 occurred on a Sunday, totaling 718.
- ↓ In 2022, the majority of fatal accidents occurred between 2:00 am and 2:59 am (259).
- ↑ The majority of fatal accidents in 2022 occurred in September (384).
- 1,480 individuals were killed in speed-related crashes in 2022.
- ↑ 488 individuals were killed in distracted drivingrelated crashes in 2022.
- ↑ 1,463 individuals were killed in alcohol-related crashes in 2022.
- → There were 562 motorcyclists (operators and passengers) killed in 2022. 51.4% (244) were not wearing helmets at the time of the crash.
- ↑ Pedestrian fatalities totaled 816 in 2022.
- ↓ Pedalcyclist fatalities totaled 91 in 2022.
- ↓ There were two crashes that resulted in six or more fatalities in 2022.
- ↑ 513 individuals died in crashes involving an unlicensed driver in 2022.
